The Out-Of-Scope event (control unit will not be necessary) has to be recorded by the driver at the tachograph; start and end has to be registered. Additionally, input/registration of data regarding the country that took place prior to this event will be listed.

By choosing the menu option **"Reports/Vehicle/Out of Scope"** you are able to view all reports you requested by defining specific search criteria.

In case the start or the end of the Out-of-Scope event lies beyond the selected time period, the duration will be calculated from the beginning or the end of the time frame. Another reason for a lack of a start or end date of an Out-of-Scope event might be missing vehicle data.
